



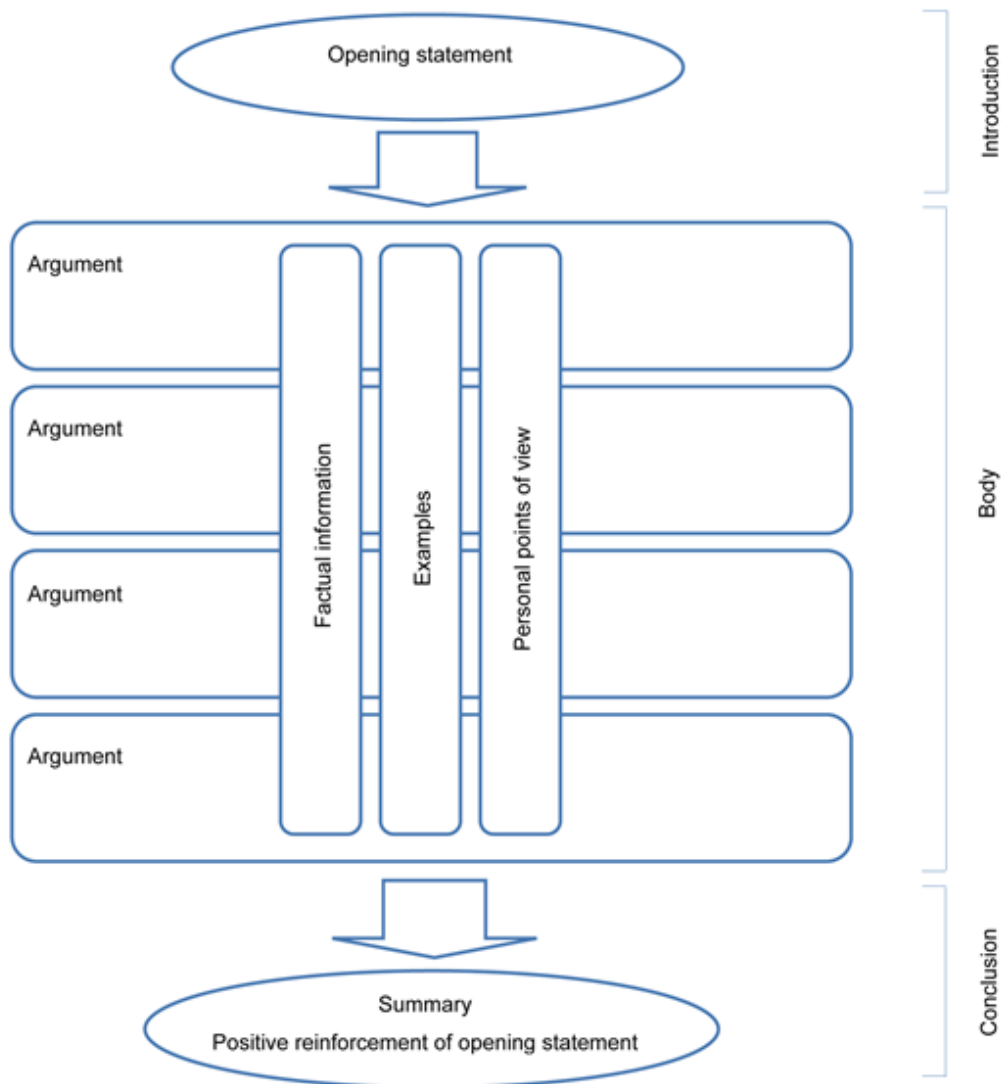

- Language features:**
- Use present tense
 - Use positive and/or emotive language that show the author's attitude
 - Use connectives that show cause and effect, eg. *an outcome of, as a result of, because, caused by, consequently, etc.*
